

# Project Rollway 2022

Project Rollway is an annual fashion show held each summer at Shepherd Center that features fashion modeling by current and former teenage patients from our Adolescent Rehabilitation Program, which focuses on returning teenagers to the highest level of functioning and independence as possible after spinal cord or brain injury. This year's show was extra special as it was the first time it was held since 2019. The event provides a way for former patients to reconnect with friends and provides inspiration to current patients. They can look at the participants and see there is life after injury.

Adolescents who sustain life-altering injuries have developmental and emotional needs that are different from adults. The adolescent program focuses on helping these individuals return to a healthy lifestyle with the highest possible level of function and independence. Shepherd Center has more experience treating teenagers with these kinds of injuries than general rehabilitation facilities.
